

FAQs for 100 Day Challenge users

General

When will 100 Day Challenge app and website be shut down?

From **Tuesday 31 December**, you will no longer be able access the 100 Day Challenge community forum via the app and website (100dc.com.au).

You will be able to access the other features of the 100 Day Challenge app and website for a further 100 days until **10 April 2025.** After this date the app and website will no longer be available online.

What will happen to 100 Day Challenge users?

100 Day Challenge users will be invited to continue their journey on the Gambling Help Online website (gamblinghelponline.org.au). This website not only offers you a forum for the 100 Day Challenge, but also provides you with a range of online support options, information and resources to support you.

Why is this happening?

We know that people need different types of support during the various stages of their recovery journey, so this change will give more people the help they need, when they need it.

By moving across to the 100 Day Challenge forum into the Gambling Help Online website (gamblinghelponline.org.au), people experiencing gambling issues will be able to access a broad range of support options, in addition to a community forum, all in the one place!

- share your progress data in your first post on the forum to introduce yourself and inspire others to join the challenge.

Technical questions

What happens to my data?

Your data from the 100 Day Challenge (personal details, activity and posts) will be destroyed after the app and website are taken offline on 10 April 2025.

Your data will not be shared or provided to anyone.

How will my privacy be protected in 100 Day Challenge forum on the Gambling Help Online website?

The 100 Day Challenge forum on the Gambling Help Online website is public so if you wish to be anonymous when you post, we recommend that you use an alias as your username. Just as you would for any other online platform, avoid posting personal information that can identify you.

Can I still use Reset app with the same login?

Yes, the Reset app will continue to be available, and you will be able to use your same login at <u>resetapp.com.au</u>.

Will the app just disappear from my phone or do I have to delete it?

You will need to delete the app from your phone.
